To establish and reach agreement on a set of criteria for technical assessment and technical procedures for technical implementation and monitoring of adoption of sustainable rice farming practices;

Summary scope of contract:

- To conduct TOT training for project provinces on technical implementation for and monitoring and evaluation of farmer adoption;
- To support PAFOs and DAFOs and their technical and consulting units in technical implementation for and monitoring and evaluation of farmer adoption on a yearly basis to provide the basis for further investments in following years;
- To provide technical support, including technical training for technical departments and institutions of MAF and PAFOs (i.e. crop production models, extension, plant protection, water saving techniques, post-harvest technology and marketing, etc.) for effective implementation of sustainable

rice farming programs;

- To support provinces in establishing productive alliances between farmers (and their organizations) and agribusinesses to improve quality and marketability of farm produce; provide technical advice on brand building for agribusinesses participating in the project; and,
- To review and evaluate GHG emission reduction calculated under LACP project.
